Parent Community Forum: Best Use of Time – 2024 Timetable Proposal

Following our *Best Use* of *Time* forum on Thursday 4 May, we have continued to pursue concepts such as early commencement of VET subjects in Stage 5 (Years 9 and 10), the possibility of dual credentialling for the HSC with a Diploma of Commerce, and the introduction of interest electives that can be catered for when we maintain indicative hours for the core curriculum.

With the above in mind, I invite you to attend our next Community Forum as we continue to explore how we can best use time to enable flexibility and choice for your children as they engage in their learning.

At our upcoming forum we will provide some modelling of the mechanics and operations of how we might design our 2024 Timetable. We will also seek feedback from parents about what the thinking is on the ideas mentioned above. The College Leadership Team would welcome your attendance on Wednesday 21 June so we can continue this important conversation as part of an extensive consultation process.
