#### Year 10 Vaccinations

The 2023 vaccination program for Year 10 students will commence on **Thursday 20 July** (Week 1 of Term 3). All Year 10 students will be offered: Meningococcal ACWY Conjugate Vaccine.

Students are to wear winter sports uniform. Please ensure your child has a good breakfast on Thursday morning and arrives with a water bottle.

This year parents can provide consent online for their child's routine school vaccinations. Vaccination will only be provided at school if consent has been received. Visit the [NSW Health website](#) and follow the prompts to complete the School Vaccination Consent Form.

#### College Uniform

In 2020, Chevalier College made the decision to implement a new uniform which will have been phased in over three years by the end of 2023.

We write to remind you that commencing in Term 1 2024, the old uniform will no longer be able to be worn to school. The exception to this will be for Year 12 2024 students, who are permitted to wear their current uniform while it remains in good condition.

The College has reached this decision as the old uniforms are now looking worn and we also wish to ensure consistency in the uniform and pride in appearance across the school.

From Term 1 2024 the following items will no longer be part of the uniform for students in Years 7 to 11:

- Canterbury style black jacket
- Junior blue chambray shirt
- Senior white shirt without the crest and piping
- Older style light grey boys shorts
- Older style light grey boys trousers
- Woollen jumper without the blue trim
- Woollen vests
- Maroon blazer without the black trim
- Black blazer without the maroon trim
- Blue sports shirts
- Sports jackets
- Older style maroon sports shorts
- White socks with 'Chevalier' written on them.

Furthermore, the following changes have been made to the girls uniform:

- Skirt and blouse – to be worn only in the winter (Terms 2 and 3). These items will no longer be a summer option.
- Summer dress – to be worn in the summer (Terms 1 and 4).
- Culottes and slacks – will no longer be available due to very low demand.

Please note that girls are still permitted to wear the longer skirts.
